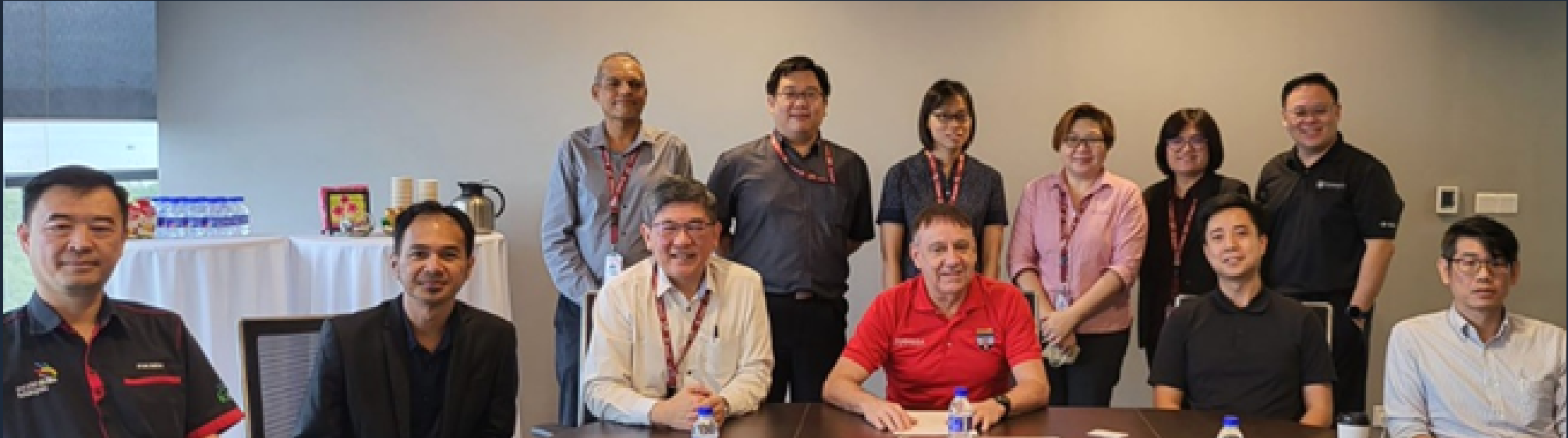

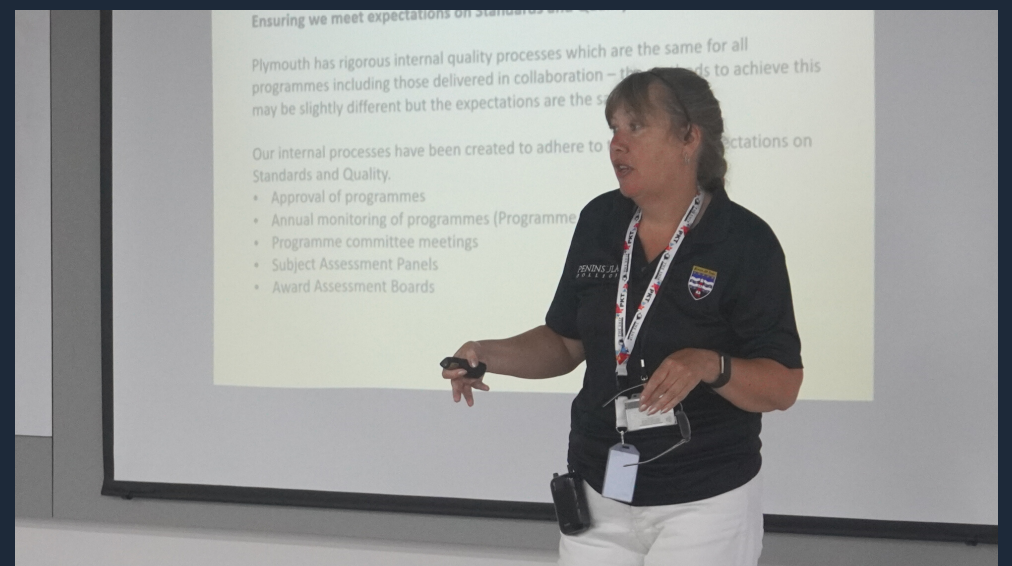
Professor Jones joked that he crashes ship for a living and illustrated the real-world applications of the field and demonstrated how vulnerabilities in ships' cybersecurity systems could result in staggering losses amounting to millions of dollars, which explains the high demand for Maritime Cybersecurity graduates in the logistics industry.

Bridging Cultural Gap between UoP and Peninsula

In September 2022, Peninsula College Georgetown hosted a visit from our esteemed partner, the University of Plymouth, represented by five delegates - Dr. Claire Grey, Dr. Rania Naguib, Dr. Shirley Atkinson, Dr. Rumbi Mukonoweshuro and Dr. Sarah Tuck.

Academics from UoP highlighted the cultural and institutional differences in assessment in a sharing session which covered a wide array of topics like designing assessment rubrics, understanding expected outcomes at each level of studies, dealing with academic offences, and giving feedback to students.

Students pursuing their Bachelor's degrees in Peninsula College Georgetown can be certain that the quality of education they receive is on par with the ones in the UK as the same syllabus is used and all lecturers teaching UoP's bachelor degrees undergo a stringent vetting process.
